12/1/11	The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has released a list of around 46,000 cable operators registered in the various Head Post Offices spread across the country.
15/1/11	The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) has announced extension of the last date to 31 January for receiving the views of stakeholders on its consultation paper relating to interconnection regulation in non-addressable cable TV sector.
